

Academic Coaching at Higher Secondary level

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ABSTRACT

Coaching has become such a ubiquitous concept that it can connote any professional practice for empowering students and unlocking their potentials to make the most of thier performance and achieve goals. The present study reveals the attitude of students towards coaching at a higher secondary level. A survey was conducted to collect data from students of class 11 in Daltonganj City of Jharkhand. Standardized tool was used among 162 sample with a quantitative research approach. Survey method was used for collecting data. The study shows the findings on attitude towards coaching among the students of higher secondary schools.

Hypotheses of the study:

- 1. There will be no significant difference in the attitude of higher secondary level male and female students towards coaching.
- 2. There will be no significant difference in the attitude of higher secondary level science and arts students towards coaching.

Delimitation:

Due to limited time and limited available resources the study has been delimited in the following grounds:

- 1. This study was delimited in twelve secondary schools only.
- 2. This study was limited to C.B.S.E school in Daltongunj.
- 3. This study was limited to 11th class students only.
- 4. Only, 162 sample size has been taken.

Research Methodology:

Quantitative Research approach was taken up in the present study. Survey method was used for collecting data. Random sampling technique was applied. Primary data gathered by distributing the questionnaire to the respondents, parametric statistical application was used for data analysis.

Tools used for the study

Standardized tool was used for collecting data. The tools used in the study are the Scale of students' attitude towards coaching for pupil teachers. It is a standardized tool constructed and developed by Dr Poorva Jain department of education Dr Hari Singh Gaur University Sagar, Madhya Pradesh.

Analysis and interpretation of data

This chapter deals with analysis of data collection with the help of various tools of study. This study finds out the attitude of higher secondary school students towards coaching.


HYPOTHESIS 1

There will be no significant difference in the attitude of higher secondary male and female students towards coaching.

On the basis of table 1, mean of male is 102.54 and mean of female is 100.69 and standard deviation of female group is 21.36 and standard deviation of male group is 20.20. The value of t-test is 0.57 which is smaller than table value 1.97 .So hypothesis is accepted Means, no significant difference found between male and female students' attitude towards coaching.

Discussion:-


Male students are having greater mean value. May be they need more guidance and support from a coaching institute for career building in comparison to females.

On the basis of table mean of science students and arts students .Standard deviation of science students and arts students are 16.24 ans 16.4 respectively. t-test value is 0.98. Which is smaller than table value. Statistically no significant difference in science and arts students' attitude towards coaching is found. So the hypothesis is accepted.

DISCUSSION

The mean value of science students is a little bit greater than arts students'. May be the science students are more aware towards the coaching for career selection in medical and engineering. That is why they have a positive attitude towards coaching after matriculation/10th standard.

Major findings of the study

- 1. There is no significant difference found in attitude of male and female students towards coaching.
- 2. There is no significant difference found in attitude of science and arts students.

Conclusion

From the above discussion and result we can say that nowadays coaching has become a need for a learner in every level of education. Through the present study it is found that most of them supported the coaching at senior secondary level. According to them coaching is a notable media for good results in examinations. Coaching gives support in achieving their career goal. Most of the students of higher Secondary Level prefer coaching and tuitions for preparation and good performance in competitive exams. Science students were found to be more aware about coaching in comparison to arts students. There is a need to strengthen our education system with teaching and learning strategies, so that students can perform better without coaching in academics and career building.
